#### **Opportunity Junction – Getting people off welfare and back to work.**

Founded in 1999, Opportunity Junction fights poverty by helping low-income adults gain the skills and confidence to support themselves and their families. At Opportunity Junction, technology, literacy and personal development combine with real world experience to put people on the road to economic self-sufficiency. They have had a remarkable 85% success rate in placing people into jobs that pay double the minimum wage.



#### **Delta Memorial Hospital Foundation – Providing a low cost walk-in clinic and free wellness class to the community.**

Founded in 1977, Delta Memorial Hospital Foundation is a separately incorporated non-profit organization with a charter to raise money for health care services in East County. To that end they support a clinic which operates Monday through Friday 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. which sees uninsured patients ages 1 to 64 who only need to verify residency and pay a minimum of \$20 per visit. In addition, the foundation offers free classes for managing diabetes and smoking cessation. After a client has been to the classes there is a direct link to the reduction in emergency/hospital visit linked to their issue.



#### **Bay Area Rescue Mission: Helping the homeless and destitute recover and get back on their feet.**

Founded in 1965, the Bay Area Rescue mission has been providing food, shelter, warm showers, and fresh clean clothes for the body. Once the homeless person has received a warm bed they have access to: A gospel message of eternal hope for the soul, GED preparation, job skills training in several areas, parenting classes, and counseling. Finally, while at the Bay Area Rescue Mission they receive compassion, and friendship.

### **Roever and Associates – Providing support for our veterans.**

During his first tour in Vietnam Dave Roever survived the explosion of a phosphorous grenade which exploded in his hand. After many surgeries and time for healing, Dave searched for a way to give to the community. In 1981 he founded Roever & Associates with the vision of delivering a message of hope and healing to adults and teenagers across America by using his life as an example of what a person can endure and recover from. Today, he travels the world with this message. In 2004, Dave secured property in Colorado and built the Eagles Summit Ranch debt free. The ranch provides a place for our veterans to recover from the horrific things seen during combat free of charge. The U.S. Military has expressed their gratitude to Dave for providing a facility that takes our wounded veterans and allows them to heal and become productive members of society again. Without Eagles Summit Ranch most of these veterans would end up in an institution for the rest of their lives. The facility has been so successful that the U.S. Military has asked Dave to build another facility in Texas. Dave will build it without costing the tax payers one dollar to give thanks to the men and women who sacrifice for our country.

## International



### **Royal Family Kids Camp – Providing inspiration and caring to foster children.**

Founded in 1985, Royal Family KIDS Camp endeavors to create life-changing memories for abused and neglected children ages 7-11, in a one-week camp experience. During the 2011 summer, Royal Family KIDS Camp was able to impact approximately 7,000 foster children in camps held around the US and internationally. By providing these camps where there is one counselor for every two children, the children receive caring and supportive interaction with trained adults. The Camp program is followed up with Clubs and Mentoring for a truly impactful experience. The programs are designed to restore critical elements in the child's life that have been missing as a result of being in the foster care system.



### **Convoy of Hope – First responders to large disasters and providing services to the needy.**

Founded in 1984, Convoy of Hope created citywide outreach events that would give away groceries, help people find jobs, and present the Gospel. By 2006 Convoy of Hope has given out over \$100 million worth of food and supplies to people in need. They have become first responders to national and international disasters by quickly mobilizing a steady supplying of food, blankets and supplies. To date their efforts have helped over 26 million people. They have built large a distribution center which is combined with a fleet of 18-wheeler trucks that can respond quickly to disaster and provide relief to people in distress.
